Introduction to Lighting Technology

Delivered lecture and teaching labs for an in-depth introduction to the scope of the field of lighting technology in Entertainment. The class includes learning to hang and focus lights, rigging an electric, Power math and practical applications of a found location, ETC lon programming, how to write a shop order, maintenance and upkeep of equipment, basic moving light training, TV and video lighting and history of lighting technologies.

Technology: Vectorworks, Lightwright Class size: 16 students per semester Electricity for Live Entertainment

2019-Present

Delivered lecture and teaching labs for an introduction to Electrical Theory supported on practical examples and emphasizing the safe use of electricity in entertainment and media. This course also covers a quick overview of the most basic devices that manipulate and transform electricity in modern life like Generators, Transformers, Motors, etc. Electrical fundamentals such as voltage, current, power and resistance are introduced. Ohm's law and the Power law are covered, using practical examples from the field. Simple electrical circuits, including series and parallel, are introduced. Specific methods of power generation and distribution are covered.

Class size: 19-26 students per semester

Culmination Advisor 2019-Present

Advisor for senior thesis project, utilizing skills in an innovative way to develop a project that relates to the entertainment industry. Projects are developed through courses in the entertainment technology and/or emerging media technology programs. Projects require approval by the advisor and must demonstrate management, technical design, and presentation skills. Documentation of planning, design and realization is presented to a committee of instructors, both in entertainment technology and related disciplines, as well as to industry professionals selected by the student and approved by the advisor. Though students enroll in this course during their senior year, development of the project should begin during the second semester of the junior year.
